

50-years birthday challenge on the 6th of December 2016 from a Finnish ultra-sport competitor Tero Hyppölä.

The person who will first accomplish all the following five achievements within the next 10 year will be given 2500 USD by Tero Hyppölä. The achievements must be reached with the same rules and at least the same results than Tero has done. If Tero dies before he gets 60 year old and nobody has accomplished the mission so far, then this given price money for the challenge will be abandoned. Inflation will not be counted and the fee will remain the same during that 10 years period.

Here are the achievements and the rules. All ratings mean Elite / Pro -category.

1. Triathlon ITU Long Distance World Championship or Hawaii Ironman WC, 7th place and time (3,8-180-42,2) no more than 8.32.47.
2. Double Triathlon IUTA World Championship race 3rd place and time (7,6-360-84,4) no more than 22.27.02.
3. 24 hour running IAU World Championship race 17th place with the distance at least 244 572 meters.
4. Traditional Sulkava rowing course 58 km by swimming in time no more than 21 h 26 minutes. Rotation direction of Partala Island can be clockwise or counterclockwise. Wetsuit, swimming cap, goggles and swimming suit are allowed. Other equipment are not allowed. Safety boat shall not be touched and the safety boat shall not be used for towing the swimmer by boats current. Stopping at the shore is allowed, but it will be calculated to the total time.
5. Utti army patrol skiing 350 km in the maximum time of 48 hours. No outside help is allowed. Same skis must be used from the beginning to the end. Food, drinks or any other supplies shall not be left before hand on the skiing court, except to the end stations. The skis must be patrol skis, which can be cheaply rented from the organizer. Boots must be army skiing boots, which can as well be rented from the organizer.

If a person has done any of these achievements before 6th of December 2016 those will be calculated. Tero Hyppölä has promised a free safety boat for Sulkava swimming when a candidate has done at least three of the other achievements before the swimming.
